





Metro Houston Race/Ethnicity








Youth Population

% of Racial/Ethnic Group Under 18 Years







Married Couple Households







Marital Status




Population 15 and Older, Currently Married*



Population 15 and Older, Never Married*



Educational Attainment




Adult Population without High School Diploma*


Adult Population With Diploma or GED*


Adult Population With Associates Degree or Some College*

Adult Population With Bachelor's Degree or Higher*








Women 15 to 50 years who had a birth in the past 12 months

Percentage of Births to Unmarried Women in the past 12 months*










Population 18 – 64 With a Disability





Population Over 65 With a Disability






Median Household Income in '18





Median Family Income in '18






Percent Population 1 Year and Older that Resided in a Different House 1 Year Ago





Median Value of Owner-Occupied Home






Private Health Insurance Coverage





No Health Insurance Coverage






Poverty Rates for Families





Poverty Rates for Families with Related Children Under 18




